Q2. What must you do when approaching a stop sign?

Answer: Come to a complete stop before the line, check for traffic, and proceed when safe.

Q3. When may you cross a solid white line in the road?

Answer: Only when avoiding an obstruction and it is safe to do so.

Q4. What does a red traffic light mean?

Answer: Stop and wait behind the stop line until the light turns green.

Q5. When are you allowed to use a cell phone while driving?

Answer: Only when using a proper hands-free kit.

Q6. What is the legal alcohol limit for drivers of motor vehicles?

Q13. What must you do before changing lanes?

Answer: Check mirrors, blind spots, and signal your intention.

Q14. When is it legal to overtake another vehicle on the left?

Answer: When the vehicle is turning right and it is safe to do so.

Q15. What is the minimum following distance you must keep under normal conditions?

Answer: At least 2 seconds behind the vehicle in front of you
